The following questions and answers were raised either by individuals attending the first H.I.S. Meetings or through phone conversations with campaign committee members

What exactly is the First Fruits Offering?

The First Fruits Offering will take place during corporate worship on March 7th. It is a special Sunday of giving that launches our three-year commitment to the campaign. For individuals who are feeling led to participate, but are not making a three-year commitment, First Fruits Offering is an opportunity for a one-time sacrificial gift. For those making a three year pledge, it is the first installment or start of that period of giving. However, this is also an opportunity to pray regarding the possibility of a gift that is “over and above” your extended commitment.

Is it considered the “first installment” or is it separate from the pledge? See above

When would we begin giving our pledges?

The first Sunday of giving is First Fruits Sunday on March 7th.



The plan only shows the addition of four new preschool classrooms. Is this going to add the needed space to accommodate future growth in our children’s area?

The master plan calls for us to utilize the space we already have by creating two different children’s worship hours. Children in grades K – 2nd will attend Bible Study first hour and Children’s Worship second hour. Those in grades 3rd – 5th will attend Children’s Worship first hour and Bible Study second hour. This “flip flop” will double the classroom space available for children at any given hour.

The construction plan calls for additional preschool rooms because of the inability to create a similar plan for babies, toddlers or Pre-K children. We also have some flexibility within the facility for re-classifying rooms based on our areas of greatest need.

What will happen when people don’t honor their pledges?

Our finance office tracks giving and will have pledge numbers and amounts. This information is strictly confidential. Each individual will receive quarterly giving statements, but **no one** will contact you regarding your pledge. This is a confidential matter between you and God.

How will we get new members involved in the campaign in the future?

New members will be invited to participate along the way, especially at key times such as ground breaking and first and second anniversaries of the campaign. Additionally, new members will have an opportunity to learn more about Willing Hearts in the New Members classes.

Has the project gone through a thorough value engineering process?

Our expansion team has worked with HH Architects and Medco Construction to determine costs estimates on the project. Those members of the team with construction expertise will review the projections. These individuals will also represent the church to ensure we are receiving the best possible value for the work.
